

The Church of Saint Andrew Elementary School Registration Information

**New registration for K-8 will begin Monday, March 15, 2010,
by appointment only. Please call the school office, 215-968-2685.**

All registration must be submitted with the following items.
Registrations cannot be accepted without the proper paperwork.

Your child will not be considered for acceptance
until all forms have been received and processed.

A copy of your child's Baptismal Certificate

If baptized at Saint Andrew Church, only date of baptism is needed.

A copy of your child's State Birth Certificate

Kindergarten: child must be 5 years of age on or before September 1, 2010.

First grade: child must be 6 years of age on or before September 1, 2010.

Preschool 3 yr old: must be 3 years of age on or before September 1, 2010.

Preschool 4 yr old: must be 4 years of age on or before September 1, 2010.

All Sacramental information

We must have Complete dates and names of church for Penance, Eucharist and Confirmation (if applicable).

Registration Fee

A \$100 non-refundable, non-transferable registration fee per child is required.

This is applied to your 2010-2011 tuition.

A Completed Church of Saint Andrew Financial Agreement

This form is included in the registration packet you receive at registration.

There are two payment plans available, monthly withdrawal or payment in full by July 1st. If you select direct monthly withdrawal, a voided check for a checking account or a voided preprinted deposit slip for a savings account, along with a copy of a credit card (FOR BACK-UP PURPOSES ONLY) will be needed to complete your Financial Agreement.

Your family identification number

This may be found on your weekly parish donation envelope.

A Current immunization record signed by the doctor

A health history form, FOR GRADES K-8 ONLY, is included in the registration packet you receive at the time of registration. This form must be completed by a parent and included with your immunization record.

If divorced or separated

A copy of the court order pertaining to custody (if applicable) or a note from a parent explaining custody arrangements.

Test Results

The results of any testing (psychological, physical, educational, disability, etc.) that has been done for the student being registered.
